**To declare Finance as a major, Student must make an A or B in ACCT 2300 and FIN 3320**  
 The Area of Finance recommends that Finance majors take at least 12 semester hours of Accounting.  
 This should be accomplished by taking ACCT 3305 for a Group B requirement.

**UPPER DIVISION CORE**

**18 HOURS – MINIMUM GRADES OF C ARE REQUIRED.**

- BLAW 3391 Business Law I.** Prerequisite: Minimum 2.75 adjusted Tech GPA.
- FIN 3320 Financial Management.** Prerequisite: ACCT 2300, 2301, ECO 2301, 2302, and MATH 2345, and minimum 2.75 adjusted Tech GPA. To declare Finance as a major student must make an A or B in FIN 3320.
- ISQS 3344 Introduction to Production and Operations Management.** Prerequisite: ISQS 2340 and MATH 2345, and minimum 2.75 adjusted Tech GPA.
- MKT 3350 Introduction to Marketing.** Prerequisite: ECO 2301, and minimum 2.75 adjusted Tech GPA.
- MGT 3370 Organization and Management.** Prerequisite: Minimum 2.75 adjusted Tech GPA.
- MGT 3373 Managerial Communication.** Prerequisite: ISQS 2340 and minimum grade of C in ENGL 1301 and 1302, and minimum 2.75 adjusted Tech GPA.

**MAJOR COURSES**

**30 HOURS – MINIMUM GRADES OF C ARE REQUIRED.**

- ACCT 3304 Intermediate Accounting I.** Prerequisite: ACCT 2300 with a minimum grade of B.
- FIN 3321 Financial Statement Analysis.** Prerequisite: FIN 3320 with a minimum grade of A or B.
- FIN 3322 Corporation Finance I.** Prerequisite: FIN 3320 with a minimum grade of A or B.
- FIN 3323 Introduction to Financial Markets and Institutions.** Prerequisite: FIN 3320 with a minimum grade of A or B.
- FIN 4324 Investments.** Prerequisite: FIN 3320 with a minimum grade of A or B.
- FIN 4385 Senior Finance Seminar.** Prerequisite: FIN 3320 with a minimum grade of A or B, senior standing and final semester.

**GROUP A – Three courses chosen from the following:**

- FIN 3332 Real Estate Fundamentals.** Prerequisite: FIN 3320 with a minimum grade of A or B.
- FIN 3334 Real Estate Finance.** Prerequisite: FIN 3320 with a minimum grade of A or B.
- FIN 3336 Principles of Insurance.** Prerequisite: FIN 3320 with a minimum grade of A or B.
- FIN 4323 Management of Financial Institutions.** Prerequisite: Fin 3321 and 3323 and FIN 3320 with a minimum grade of A or B.
- FIN 4325 Principles of Portfolio Management.** Prerequisite: ACCT 3304, FIN 3321 and FIN 4324.
- FIN 4326 Student Managed Investment Fund.** Prerequisite: FIN 3321, FIN 4324 and consent of instructor.
- FIN 4327 Derivative Securities and Markets.** Prerequisite: FIN 3321 and FIN 3320 with a minimum grade of A or B.
- FIN 4328 International Finance.** Prerequisite: FIN 3323 and Fin 3320 with a minimum grade of A or B.
- FIN 4329 Fixed Income Analysis.** Prerequisite: Fin 3321, Fin 3323 and FIN 3320 with a minimum grade of A or B.
- FIN 4330 Corporation Finance II.** Prerequisite: ACCT 3304, FIN 3321, and FIN 3320 with a minimum grade of A or B.
- FIN 4333 Real Estate Appraisal.** Prerequisite: FIN 3332 or 3334.
- FIN 4335 Real Estate Investments.** Prerequisite: FIN 3334.
- FIN 4336 Urban Land Development.** Prerequisite: FIN 3332 or 3334.
- FIN 4383 Special Topics in Finance.** Prerequisite: Consent of instructor.

**Group B – One course chosen from the following:**

Any of the Finance courses listed above which were not used to satisfy the Group A requirement or one of the following:

- ACCT 3305 Intermediate Accounting II.** Prerequisite: ACCT 3304 with a minimum grade of B
- ACCT 3306 Principles of Cost and Managerial Accounting.** Prerequisite: ACCT 2301 with a minimum grade of B.
- ACCT 3315 Accounting Systems.** Prerequisite: ACCT 3304 with a minimum grade of B.
- BLAW 3393 Real Estate Law.**
- ECO 3312 Intermediate Economic Theory.** Prerequisite: ECO 2301.
- ECO 3330 Economic Systems.** Prerequisite: ECO 2301 & 2302.
- ECO 4323 Monetary Theory.** Prerequisite: ECO 3311.
- FIN 4382 Internship in Finance.** Prerequisite: At least six hours of professional courses (excluding core courses), to be determined by the Area faculty.
- MKT 3356 Marketing Research and Analysis.** Prerequisite: MATH 2345, and MKT 3350 with a minimum grade of C.

**UPPER LEVEL ECONOMICS REQUIREMENT**

**CHOOSE 2 FROM THE FOLLOWING – 6 HOURS – MINIMUM GRADE OF C IS REQUIRED**

- ECO 3311 Intermediate Macroeconomics.** Prerequisite: ECO 2302
- ECO 3320 Managerial Economics.** Prerequisite: ECO 2301
- ECO 3324 Government Finance.** Prerequisite: ECO 2302
- ECO 3326 Industrial Organization, Antitrust, and Regulation.** Prerequisite: ECO 2301

**NON-BUSINESS / NON-ECONOMICS ELECTIVES**

**6 HOURS OR ENOUGH TO COMPLETE THE 120-HOUR REQUIREMENT – MINIMUM GRADES OF D ARE REQUIRED.**

Six hours of non-business/non-economics electives are needed to have the 50% required by AACSB accreditation standards. Three of the six hours should be taken in the Lower Division. These courses are eligible for the pass/fail option.

All courses are not offered each semester and only a limited number of courses are taught in the summer (due to funding restrictions and available faculty).
