**UPPER DIVISION CORE**

**18 HOURS – MINIMUM GRADES OF C ARE REQUIRED.**

<b>BLAW 3391</b>	<b>Business Law I.</b> Prerequisite: Minimum 2.75 adjusted Tech GPA.
<b>FIN 3320</b>	<b>Financial Management.</b> Prerequisite: ACCT 2300, 2301, ECO 2301, 2302, and MATH 2345, and minimum 2.75 adjusted Tech GPA. To declare Finance as a major student must make an A or B in FIN 3320
<b>ISQS 3344</b>	<b>Introduction to Production and Operations Management.</b> Prerequisite: ISQS 2340 and MATH 2345, and minimum 2.75 adjusted Tech GPA.
<b>MKT 3350</b>	<b>Introduction to Marketing.</b> Prerequisite: ECO 2301, and minimum 2.75 adjusted Tech GPA.
<b>MGT 3370</b>	<b>Organization and Management.</b> Prerequisite: Minimum 2.75 adjusted Tech GPA.
<b>MGT 3373</b>	<b>Managerial Communication.</b> Prerequisite: ISQS 2340 and minimum grade of C in ENGL 1301 and 1302, and minimum 2.75 adjusted Tech GPA.

<b>ACCT 3304</b>	<b>Intermediate Accounting I.</b> Prerequisite: ACCT 2300 with a minimum grade of B.
<b>FIN 3321</b>	<b>Financial Statement Analysis.</b> Prerequisite: FIN 3320 with a minimum grade of A or B.
<b>FIN 3322</b>	<b>Corporation Finance I.</b> Prerequisite: FIN 3320 with a minimum grade of A or B.
<b>FIN 3323</b>	<b>Introduction to Financial Markets and Institutions.</b> Prerequisite: FIN 3320 with a minimum grade of A or B.
<b>FIN 4324</b>	<b>Investments.</b> Prerequisite: FIN 3320 with a minimum grade of A or B.
<b>FIN 4385</b>	<b>Senior Finance Seminar.</b> Prerequisite: FIN 3320 with a minimum grade of A or B, senior standing and final semester.

**GROUP A – Three courses chosen from the following:**

<b>FIN 3332</b>	<b>Real Estate Fundamentals.</b> Prerequisite: FIN 3320 with a minimum grade of A or B.
<b>FIN 4325</b>	<b>Principles of Portfolio Management.</b> Prerequisite: ACCT 3304, FIN 3321 and FIN 4324.
<b>FIN 4326</b>	<b>Student Managed Investment Fund.</b> Prerequisite: FIN 3321 FIN 4324 and consent of instructor.
<b>FIN 4327</b>	<b>Derivative Securities and Markets.</b> Prerequisite: FIN 3321 and FIN 3320 with a minimum grade of A or B.
<b>FIN 4329</b>	<b>Fixed Income Analysis.</b> Prerequisite: FIN 3321, Fin 3323 and FIN 3320 with a minimum grade of A or B.
<b>FIN 4335</b>	<b>Real Estate Investments.</b> Prerequisite: FIN 3334

**GROUP B – One course chosen from the following:**

Any of the Finance courses listed above which were not used to satisfy the Group A requirement, or one of the following:

<b>FIN 3334</b>	<b>Real Estate Finance.</b> Prerequisite: FIN 3320 with a minimum grade of A or B.
<b>FIN 3336</b>	<b>Principles of Insurance.</b> Prerequisite: FIN 3320 with a minimum grade of A or B.
<b>FIN 4323</b>	<b>Management of Financial Institutions.</b> Prerequisite: Fin 3321, FIN 3323 and FIN 3320 with a minimum grade of A or B.
<b>FIN 4328</b>	<b>International Finance.</b> Prerequisite: FIN 3323 and Fin 3320 with a minimum grade of A or B.
<b>FIN 4333</b>	<b>Real Estate Appraisal.</b> Prerequisite: FIN 3332 or 3334.
<b>FIN 4336</b>	<b>Urban Land Development.</b> Prerequisite: FIN 3332 or 3334.
<b>FIN 4382</b>	<b>Internship in Finance.</b> Prerequisite: At least six hours of professional courses (excluding core courses), to be determined by Area faculty.

**NON-BUSINESS / NON-ECONOMICS ELECTIVES**

**6 HOURS OR ENOUGH TO COMPLETE THE 120-HOUR REQUIREMENT – MINIMUM GRADES OF D ARE REQUIRED.**
